Effective and Last Modified: July 3, 2024

Guerbet LLC and its affiliates ("**Guerbet**" "**we**," "**us**," or "**our**") respect your privacy. This Privacy Notice explains how we, and our affiliates, collect, use, disclose, and protect Personal Information (defined below), and your choices about the collection and use of Personal Information.

This Privacy Notice applies to Personal Information collected or processed by or on behalf of Guerbet via its websites, apps, social media pages, or other platforms that link to this Privacy Notice (collectively, the "**Site**"). This Privacy Notice also does not apply to any third party including our affiliates and subsidiaries website/content/services, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or on the website. We do not control how such third parties process your Personal Information.

Please read this Privacy Notice carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use the Site. By accessing or using this Site, you agree to this Privacy Notice. This Privacy Notice may change from time to time. Your continued use of this Site after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check this Privacy Notice periodically for updates.

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1. Why we collect your information

The term "Personal Information" or "Personal Data" can have different meanings depending on applicable law. In general, we use the term "Personal Information" or "Personal Data" to mean information that can uniquely identify you, but if a different definition applies under applicable law, that definition will apply. We collect Personal Information about you for a number of reasons, including:

For our internal efforts to operate and improve our business. This could include:

- Enabling your use of our services and fulfilling your requests for certain products and services.
- Making the Site or our current products better.
- Developing new products or new content for the Site.
- Using the information for internal financial activities like auditing, billing, and forecasting.
- Performing data analysis to identify ways we can operate more efficiently or expand our business.
- Verifying and maintaining the quality and safety of our products.
- Meeting our contractual requirements.
- Communicating with our customers.

For advertising and marketing purposes. This could include:

- Sending you information on promotions or surveys we offer, or information about us and our events.
- Enhancing, personalizing and evaluating the effectiveness of the content of our Site, our communications with you, and our advertising and marketing.

For our general administrative purposes. For example, we may need your Personal Information to tell you about important changes to the Site, manage your registered account, or provide account credit or other customer service to you. We may also need your Personal Information to administer promotions or programs we offer.

For social-media engagement. We use social-media accounts (including Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, Pinterest, and Instagram) to engage with the public. This engagement allows us to build online awareness about our company and our products; respond to messages through the comment, message, or chat functions; collect aggregated information about interactions with our content; analyze trends; identify and profile brand advocates and key influencers; and conduct social-media listening of conversations about our company and our products. When you engage with us through our social-media channels, the platform providers will also process information about you. For further information about a platform provider's processing of Personal Information, please consult the privacy policy of the platform provider.

For security purposes, as necessary to help us protect against, identify, or investigate fraud or other criminal activity.

For other legal purposes, if we have a legal obligation, or need to pursue or defend against legal claims, for which we need to process your Personal Information.

For communication purposes, to get in touch with you in connection with any of the reasons discussed above.

2. How long we keep your Personal Information

We will retain your Personal Information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Privacy Notice, unless otherwise required by applicable laws. Criteria we will use to determine how long we will retain your Personal Information include whether we need it to provide you with services you have requested; we continue to have a relationship with you; you have requested information or services from us; we have a legal right or obligation to continue to retain it; we have an obligation to a third party that involves your Personal Information; our retention or recordkeeping policies and obligations dictate that we retain your Personal Information; we have an interest in providing you with further information about our services; or we have another business or legal purpose for retaining your Personal Information.

3. What Personal Information we collect about you

We collect Personal Information from a number of sources, including directly from you, from third parties (for example, business partners, subcontractors, advertising networks, analytics providers, and information providers), and via online tracking technologies. See below for further information about the types of Personal Information we collect.

Information that you provide us. In various places on the Site we may request Personal Information from you, for example via forms we ask you to complete. The exact Personal Information we need to collect will depend on the purpose for which we request it, but may include:

- **Contact Information.** If you submit an inquiry, register for an account, or provide information on or through our Services, we may collect your contact information. This may include your name, address, company name, email address, demographic information, and phone number.
- **Commercial Information.** If you submit an inquiry, or provide information on our websites, we may collect commercial information including information about your purchases and the Services you have shown interest in.
- **Usage Information.** When you use our website, we may automatically record information, including your Internet Protocol address (IP Address), geolocation of your device, browser type, referring URLs (e.g., the website you visited before coming to our website), domain names associated with your internet service provider, and any other information regarding your interaction with our website.
- **Application for Employment Information.** If you apply for employment with us, we will collect Personal Information related to your potential employment, including your education and employment history, address and contact information, demographic information, and any other information included in your resume or application.
- **Communication Information.** We may collect Personal Information contained within your communications with us, including audio, electronic, or visual information, screen sharing views, and any files provided to us via email, chat, social media, telephone, or otherwise. Where permitted by applicable law, we may collect and maintain records of calls and chats

with our agents, representatives, or employees via message, chat, post, or similar functionality.

Information gathered automatically. When you visit the Site, we may automatically collect information directly or through our third-party analytics providers. That information may include:

- **Cookies, Device Identifiers, and Similar Technologies.** When you use or access the Site, we and our service providers may use cookies, device identifiers, and similar technologies such as pixels, web beacons, and local storage to collect usage and browser information about how you use the Site. We process the Personal Information collected through such technologies to help operate certain features of the Site, to enhance your experience through personalization, and to help us better understand the features of the Site that you and other users are most interested in. We may allow or enable third parties to collect Personal Information over time and across other websites in order to provide their interest-based advertising services, and we use Google Ads and other third parties to serve ads for our services across various websites.

- **Analytics.** To assist us with analyzing our website traffic through cookies and similar technologies, we may use analytics services, including Google Analytics. - **Log File Information.** When you use the Site, our servers may automatically record information, including your Internet Protocol address ("IP Address"), browser type, referring URLs (e.g., the site you visited before coming to our Site), domain names associated with your internet service provider, information on your interaction with the Site, and other information. We may also collect similar information from emails sent to you which then help us track which emails are opened and which links are clicked by recipients. We use Personal Information collected in this way to help secure the Site by identifying potential threats and vulnerabilities and in analyzing the effectiveness of our Site and to improve its function and content.

In addition, most browsers provide you with the ability to block, delete, or disable cookies, and your mobile device may allow you to disable transmission of unique identifiers and location data. 4. Disclosure of Personal Information

We may disclose your Personal Information in the following circumstances:

- **Affiliates.** We disclose Personal Information to our affiliated businesses. Our affiliated business may use Personal Information in accordance with this Privacy Notice, including for those affiliates' marketing purposes.
- **Our Service Providers.** We engage service providers to perform tasks on our behalf and to assist us in operating the Site and providing our services. For example, we engage third parties to provide analytics services, send newsletters, and maintain Site functionality. We take commercially reasonable steps to help ensure our service providers provide at least the same level of protection for Personal Information as we do.
- **Companies Involved in Mergers and Acquisitions Transactions.** If we sell or otherwise transfer part or the whole of our business or assets to another organization (*e.g.*, in the course of a transaction like a merger, acquisition, bankruptcy, dissolution, or liquidation), any information collected through the Site, including Personal Information, may be among the items sold or transferred.
- **Law Enforcement, Government Agencies, and Courts.** We may disclose Personal Information at the request of law enforcement or government agencies; in response to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process; to establish, protect, or exercise our rights; to defend against a legal claim; to protect the rights, property, or safety of any other person; or as otherwise required by law.
- **Other Disclosures with Your Consent.** We may disclose your Personal Information to other third parties when we are permitted to do so by applicable law, or where we have your consent or direction to do so.

5. How we protect your Personal Information

We use our commercially reasonable efforts to protect the confidentiality and security of Personal Information we process. Despite these efforts to store Personal Information in a secure operating environment, we cannot guarantee the security of Personal Information during its transmission or its storage on our systems. Further, while we attempt to ensure the integrity and security of Personal Information, we cannot guarantee that our security measures will prevent third parties such as hackers from illegally obtaining access to Personal Information. Additionally, you are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of any passwords used to access certain parts of the Site. We do not represent or warrant that Personal Information about you will be protected against, loss, misuse, or alteration by third parties. Any transmission of Personal Information is at your own risk. In the

event that we are required by law to inform you of a breach of your Personal Information we may do so electronically, in writing, or by telephone, to the extent we are permitted to do so by law.

6. Opting out of receiving electronic communications

We may send newsletters, notifications, promotions, or other information to you via email ("**Communications**"). You may choose to stop receiving Communications by clicking on the unsubscribe link at the bottom of our emails or by contacting us using the contact information in Section 11, below. Please note that certain commercial Communications are necessary for the proper functioning and use of the Site, and/or providing our products and services to you, and you may not have the ability to opt out of those Communications.

7. Transmission Of Information To Other Countries. As a multi-national company, we transmit information between and among our affiliates. As a result, your information may be processed in a foreign country where privacy laws may be less stringent than the laws in your country. Nonetheless, where possible we take steps to treat personal information using the same privacy principles that apply pursuant to the law of the country in which we first received your information. By submitting your personal information to us you agree to the transfer, storage, and processing of your information in a country other than your country of residence including, but not necessarily limited to, the United States. 8. Children's privacy

We do not knowingly collect or solicit any Personal Information from children under the age of 16. In the event that we learn that we have collected Personal Information from a child, we will promptly take steps to delete that information. 9. Links to third-party websites

We are not responsible for the practices employed by any websites or services linked to or from the Site, including the information or content contained within them. We encourage you to investigate and ask questions before disclosing Personal Information to third parties, since any Personal Information disclosed will be subject to the applicable third party's privacy notice.

10. Your rights

Depending on where you are located, you may have the following rights with respect to your Personal Information under applicable data protection laws:

- **Access.** You may have the right to know what Personal Information we have collected about you and to access such Personal Information.

- **Data portability.** You may have the right to receive a copy of your Personal Information in a portable and readily usable format.
- **Deletion.** You may have the right to delete your Personal Information that we have obtained, subject to certain exceptions.
- **Correction.** You may have the right to correct inaccuracies in your Personal Information.
- **Opt out of targeted advertising.** You may have the right to opt out of the processing of your Personal Information for purposes of targeted advertising (also known as cross-context behavioral advertising). You may opt-out of targeted advertising by clicking the cookie settings link described above or on our homepage. Please note that if you change browsers or devices, or if you clear your browser's cache, you may need to click the link again to apply your preference. You may also initiate any opt outs by broadcasting an Opt-Out Preference Signal, such as the Global Privacy Control (GPC). We honor Opt-Out Preference Signals, including GPC. If you choose to use an Opt-Out Preference Signal, you will need to turn it on for each supported browser or browser extension you use.

You will not be discriminated against in any way by virtue of your exercise of the rights listed in this Privacy Notice which means we will not deny goods or Services to you, provide different prices or rates for goods or Services to you, or provide a different level or quality of goods or Services to you. Only you, or an authorized agent that you authorize to act on your behalf, may make a request related to your Personal Information. You may also make a request on behalf of your minor child.

We must verify your identity before fulfilling your requests, and if we cannot verify your identity, we may request additional information from you. In some circumstances, you may designate an authorized agent to submit requests to exercise certain privacy rights on your behalf. If you are an authorized agent making a request on behalf of another person, we will also need to verify your identity, which may require proof of your written authorization or evidence of a power of attorney. We endeavor to respond to requests within the time period required by applicable law. If we require more time, we will inform you of the reason and extension period in writing.

We do not charge a fee to process or respond to your requests unless they are excessive or repetitive. If we determine that a request warrants a fee, we will tell you why we made that decision and provide you with a cost estimate before completing your request. We may deny certain requests, or only fulfill some in part, as permitted or required by law. If you are not satisfied with the resolution of your request and you are afforded a right to appeal such decision, you will be notified of our appeal process in our response to your request.

12. California residents

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Other California Privacy Rights

A. Basis for Processing

Our legal basis for collecting and using the Personal Information described in this Privacy Notice will depend on the Personal Information concerned and the context in which we collect it. We collect Personal Information from you:

- where we need Personal Information to perform a contract with you;
- where the processing is in our legitimate interests;
- where the processing is necessary for us to meet our applicable legal obligations; or
- if we otherwise have your consent.

The table below describes the Types of Personal Information described in Section 3 above and lists our legal basis for processing each.

Usage Information	For our legitimate interests including to understand how you interact with our website to improve it, to understand your preferences, and to help detect and prevent fraud.
Application for Employment Information	For our legitimate interests including to evaluate your eligibility for employment.
Communication Information	For our legitimate interests including providing you support services and answering your questions.
Cookies, Device Identifiers, and Similar Technologies	Where required by law, we base the use of third-party technologies upon consent.
Analytics	Where required by law, we base the use of third-party analytics technologies upon consent.
Log File Information	For our legitimate interests including to understand how you interact with our website and communications and to help detect and prevent fraud.

B. Your Privacy Rights

You may have the right to:

- **Request access** to Personal Information about you.
- **Request correction** of the Personal Information that we hold about you.
- **Request erasure** of Personal Information about you. Note, however, that we may not always be able to comply with your request of erasure for specific legal reasons which will be notified to you, if applicable, at the time of your request.
- **Object to processing** of Personal Information about you where we are relying on a legitimate interest (or those of a third party) and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground as you feel it impacts on your fundamental rights and freedoms.
- **Request restriction of processing** of Personal Information about you. You can ask us to suspend the processing of Personal Information in the following scenarios: (a) if you want us to establish the data's accuracy; (b) where our use of the data is unlawful but you do not want us to erase it; (c) where you need us to hold the data even if we no longer require it as you need it to establish, exercise or defend legal claims; or (d) you have objected to our use of your data but we need to verify whether we have overriding legitimate grounds to use it.
- **Request the transfer** of Personal Information to you or to a third party.
- **Data portability.** You may have the right to receive a copy of your Personal Information in a portable and readily usable format.

- **Withdraw consent** at any time where we are relying on consent to process Personal Information about you.

Depending on where you live, you may have a right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority or other regulatory agency if you believe that we have violated any of the rights concerning Personal Information. We may modify or update this Privacy Notice from time to time, so please review it periodically. We may provide you with notice of material changes to the Privacy Notice as appropriate under the circumstances.
